Information relating to the customer's order is subject to automated data processing. Fight against bank card fraud.

Information relating to your order is subject to automated data processing.

Fight against unpaid checks

Payment by check is accepted subject to verification with the Banque de France's national irregular checks (FNCI) file, and uses automated processing using information relating to the customer's order. This processing is authorized by the CNIL.

Consequences of fraud and unpaid bills

When the control of a payment or an order reveals unpaid bills, fraud or attempted fraud, the Customer may be entered in a file listing fraud and unpaid bills until their situation is regularized. Under these conditions, SITSH COMPANY may refuse to honor orders from customers appearing in this file until the situation is rectified.

In all cases, the customers concerned will be the subject of individual information.

In the event of a risk of fraud detected, SITSH COMPANY reserves the right to carry out a check against appeal, to request the use of another means of payment, or to cancel the order to guarantee the security of transactions. Line.

Rights of access, modification, opposition and deletion
